GSCD accepting scholarship applications

GARRETT COUNTY —

The Garrett Soil Conservation District is now accepting applications for their 2024 scholarship. The \$1000 Scholarship will be awarded for the fall

2024 semester.

To be considered, students must be planning to major in a field related to agriculture, natural resources, soil conservation, or related science.

The scholarship is open to individuals who attended, or are attending, high school in Garrett County as a Garrett County resident in either public school; private school; or homeschool. High school seniors, high school graduates planning to attend college in the fall, and those already enrolled in college are eligible to apply.

Students must have a grade point average of 3.0 or better and will be required to submit transcripts.

Each year, the GSCD awards one or more scholarships to students pursuing careers in fields that directly impact GSCD's mission to provide conservation through encouragement of best management practices in agriculture, land stewardship, and forestry.

"This year's scholarship is being funded by Farm Credit of the Virginias and the generous support of the

community through our Tree and Bush Sale fundraiser", stated a spokesperson for GSCD. "We are grateful to those who made it possible for us to support a local student in taking such a valuable step toward bettering themselves and our community."

Cristy Enlow of Friendsville was awarded the GSCD scholarship for 2023. She is studying Agrobusiness Management at Potomac State College and says she plans to return to Garrett County and open her own agricultural business in conjunction with helping to manage her family's generational farm.

"We are extremely proud of Cristy. She made the President's List this past semester", stated a GSCD spokesperson. "Cristy is a prime example of why it is so important to support our local students who are striving to make a difference in our community."

Individuals can apply for the scholarship at <https://garrettscd.org/scholarship>. The deadline to apply is May 1, 2024. In addition to the application, students will

need to submit an essay and unofficial transcript. Guidelines are stated on the website.

Those in the community who are interested in supporting the 2025 scholarship and other GSCD outreach endeavors, such as Envirothon for area high school students, 4H booth awards, conservation education, and costs associated with the local conservation efforts of the GSCD not paid by governmental funding may do so by making a purchase from the GSCD Fruit Tree and Bush Sale.

The Fruit Tree and Bush sale runs through April 1, 2024. Distribution of the fruit trees and fruit bushes ordered will be Wednesday, April 17, and Thursday, April 18, at the Garrett Soil Conservation office at 1916 Maryland Hwy, Ste C, Mt Lake Park, MD 21550. Individuals who have orders can pick up either day, any time between 9:00 am and 7:00 pm.
